CONTROL LINE STUNT RACING

The updated rules for 2026 season

This brand new competition mixes up racing with three basic stunts. All flown one up and we believe never been done before?

MODEL: Capable of ROG and able to fly loops, bunts, inverted and level flight. Full or profile fuselage with mainplane, tailplane and fin. A Peacemaker or similar will fit the bill.

ENGINE:- Up to 2.5cc iron/ steel piston/liner non schnuerle diesel/glow

LINES:- 012" Multi strand 55' centre of thrust line to centre of handle.

RACE:- Pilot + Helper with Helmet. Pilot or helper to start engine. Two minutes is allowed for the start. Pilot walks to the centre circle and signals for helper to release the model. Timing commences upon model release. After 20 laps and before 30 laps pilot signals by raising hand and flies the following stunts which must be flown in sequence and centred on the launch point: 2 Lazy Eights; 3 Inside loops; 2 laps inverted and 3 Outside Loops (bunts). On completion racing continues until 50 forward laps are completed when timing finishes. Stunts are not judged for accuracy but must be recognisable. For every stunt not flown 20 seconds will be added to the flight time The competitor with the shortest flight time is the winner.

EVENTS:- 3 x SAM 35 advertised Buckminster meetings, 1 x Modelair Meeting at Buckminster, 1 x advertised BMFA National Championships Buckminster meeting, plus UK and World Wide postal entries accepted. 3 fastest times for the whole season of four competitions declared the winners.

PRIZES:- Stunt Racing Trophies for 1st, 2nd & 3rd Places. Certificates for all entrants.
